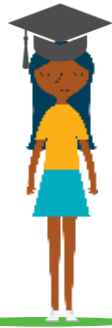


UFS Pathway to Work and Mixed Modes of Delivery

Mere is enrolled in building related full-time Provider-Based study with a TEO. After a few months, Mere's TEO supports her in gaining work-based training with a building company.



Mere begins an **apprenticeship** with a building company and is supported in her Work-Based training by the TEO. The TEO provides additional support as per the requirements for the Pathway mode.



As part of her apprenticeship, Mere enrolls in a 'Working at Heights' **block course**.



Mere has completed her apprenticeship and is now a fully qualified builder.



Provider-Based
study with a TEO

Enrol the learner in **SDR** and include in SDR submissions for the duration of their study. Use **SoF37** and **ATTEND** codes to identify provider-based or extramural mode of delivery.



Work-Based
training with a TEO

Enrol the learner in **ITR** and include in ITR submissions for each month for the duration of training*
No additional data is required in ITR for UFS.

Complete the **Pathway to Work template** on WS2.
(Pathway mode is valid for up to 30 credits / 3 months of the learner's apprenticeship)

Enrol the learner in **SDR** and include in SDR submissions for the duration of their Provider-based (block course) study
Use **SoF11** and **ATTEND** codes to identify the mode of delivery.

Complete the **Mixed-Mode Template** on WS2 to identify the training as part of a mixed mode arrangement.
