

The Data System Refresh and Gateway Schools

The Data System Refresh

- A major programme to upgrade TEC systems used for data collection and reporting
- Key changes include the new single portal (DXP Ngā Kete) and simplified processes for data submissions
- DXP Ngā Kete will replace STEO, ITR, Workspace 2 and the existing Ngā Kete (information products/Qlik apps) in stages over 2024 and 2025
- DXP Ngā Kete is already being used by TEOs for commitments data and document sharing.

DXP Ngā Kete – What's changing

- DXP Ngā Kete will replace Workspace 2 from 1 October
- There are some changes to the data and file upload process
 - > A csv file for Gateway data submissions replaces the existing excel workbook
 - > Data changes: 'Comments' is removed; 'Employer NZBN' (optional) and Region are new
 - > Validate learner data against the NSI → NSN, date of birth, and gender
 - > DXP Ngā Kete will accept uploaded files with either the new column headings or the existing WS2 workbook column headings (to support transition will revert to new column heading only in the future)
 - > 'NameID Code' data field is no longer required and has been removed

DXP Ngā Kete roles added to ESL profiles	DXP Ngā Kete replaces Workspace2 for Gateway data submissions and to view and upload documents	In the week of 21 October Gateway Actuals and Gateway Standard Actuals templates will be provisioned onto DXP Ngā Kete for you to update and submit. No change to deadlines: • Actuals by 20 December • Standard Actuals by 28 February

For now, continue using:

- <u>Ngā Kete</u> (not DXP Ngā Kete) to access Qlik Reports, including My Gateway Provision: Data quality issues sheet
- Workspace 2 to view historical returns and documents (until early 2025)




Intro to DXP Ngā Kete

Accessing DXP Ngā Kete

- You can now access DXP Ngā Kete using your <u>Education Sector Login</u> (<u>ESL</u>)
- DXP Ngā Kete roles you need have been added to your ESL user profile
- A letter with instructions on how to access DXP Ngā Kete was provisioned to your WS2 on Monday
- There are no data submissions or documents in DXP Ngā Kete yet, but we invite you to take a look around and update contact details if needed
