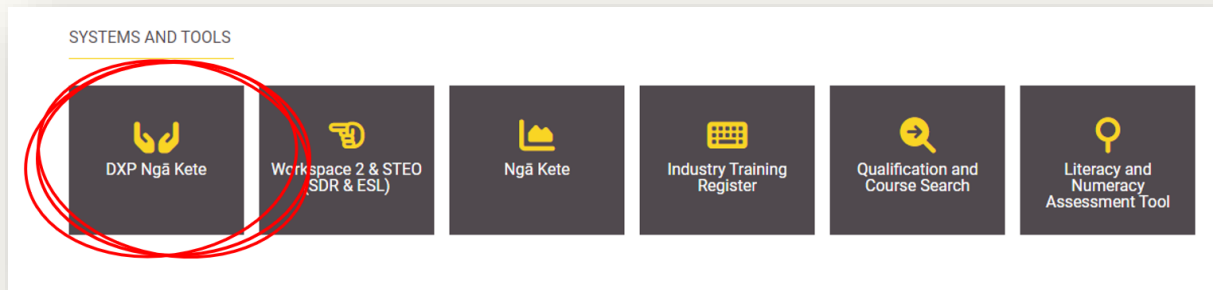

Update on DXP Ngā Kete

The Data System Refresh

- DXP Ngā Kete is our new single portal designed to simplify processes for data submissions
- It replaces STEO, ITR, Workspace 2 (WS2) and the existing Ngā Kete (information products/Qlik apps) in stages over 2024 and 2025
- DXP Ngā Kete already being used by TEOs for data submissions and document sharing



DXP Ngā Kete – What's changing

There are some changes to the data and file upload process:

- › A template in the csv file format replaces the existing excel workbook
- › Data changes: 'Comments' field is removed; 'Employer NZBN' is new (optional) and Region is new
- › Validate learner data against the NSI - NSN, date of birth, and gender
- › To support transition, DXP Ngā Kete will accept upload files in the new template format as well as, for Gateway Actuals - an alternative template with columns in the same order as the existing WS2 excel workbook including the Ethnicity 1 - 3 and Iwi 1 - 3 columns.
- › When entering reference data into the upload file, use either the reference data name or code. If using the name, be sure to use correct case (upper and lower) and macrons.
