

Ngā Kete Quick Guide

Ngā Kete makes it easy for you to access relevant material across multiple websites, both public and private, all from one central site. Ngā Kete is designed to help personalise your online experience with the Tertiary Education Commission (TEC) and allows you to securely browse and search for information simultaneously across multiple sources. Continue to use existing systems (SDR, ITR or Workspace 2) when you need to submit data or information to the TEC.

How to access

Browse for information by clicking on a subject area.

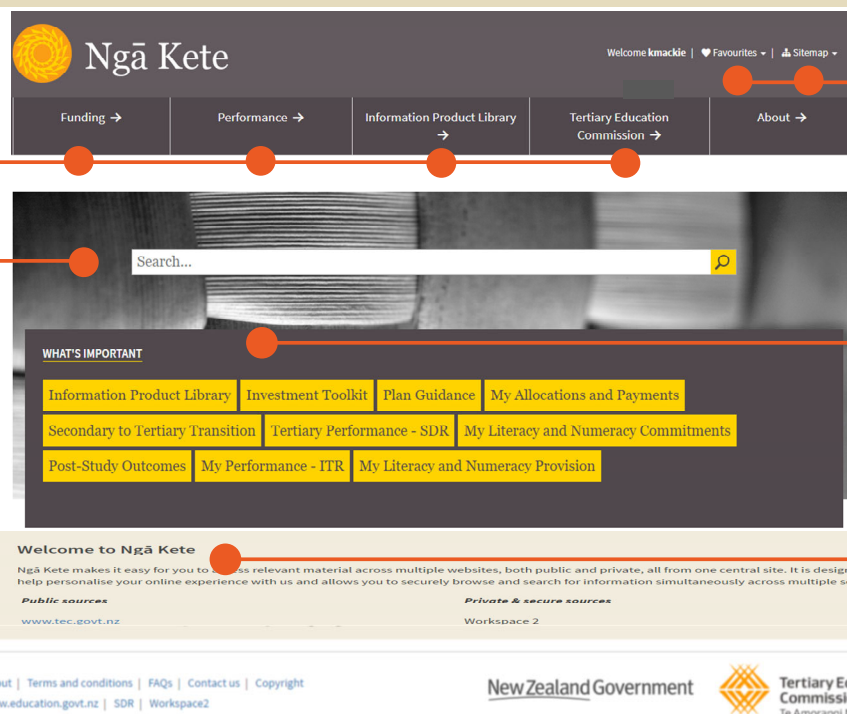
Search for information by typing in a key term and pressing Enter.

Terms of use: Detail on legal, privacy and copyright information.

Contact us: Form to provide feedback/questions.

Useful website links: link directly through to SDR or Workspace 2 without logging in again.



Favourites: View and manage your saved search criteria or document links.

Sitemap: A list of Ngā Kete pages.

What's important: Find the links that are most relevant to the current business cycle, and analysis reporting.

You'll find links to useful information posted here.

Use the search box when you know the key terms that describe what you are looking for

Wild card search: You can search by using an * at the end of a string of letters e.g. Searching for fund* will return any words starting with fund, including funds, funding, etc.

Results

Sort your results by the following criteria:

- relevance
- date (newest or oldest)
- lifetime views
- recent views

Refine your results by filtering on:

- sub sector
- fund
- source

FAVOURITE RATE HELP

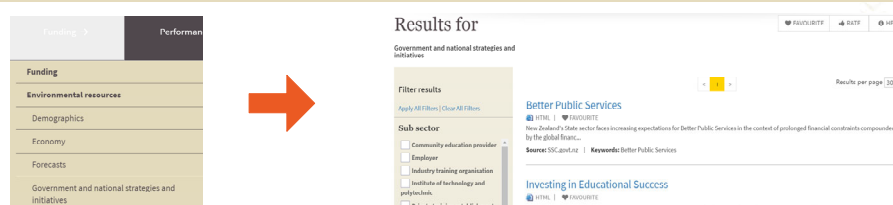
Save your results list as a favourite, rate the result, or view help text.

Search results will be displayed based on the following:

- Title
- Metadata (terms used in the document properties)
- Terms in the content of the document.

Use the subject areas to browse for information when you broadly know what you are trying to find

For example: click on one of the top menu options (E.g. Funding) and then use the drop down menu to refine further. The option to refine further will disappear when you have drilled down as far as you can go. Filter the results using one or more of the filters outlined above.
