

Selecting a school

- » When you enrol in a course, the school will ask you to sign a TEC enrolment form to give your consent for the TEC to pay your course fees.
- » Please check the course name and the fees before you sign the form.
- » All prices in the directory are in New Zealand dollars and include GST.

Withdrawal and refunds

- » If you want to withdraw from the course within the first 10 working days, inform the TEC.
- » After 10 working days the school's own refund policy will apply. Please ask the school for more information.
- » Fee refunds will be sent to the TEC and returned to your Pre-purchased English Language Tuition account.






